

WEED BARRIER MAT

Use this new weed barrier mat just as you would black plastic mulch. This new mat will allow 14 times more air and 10 times more moisture to penetrate than other woven fabrics, so you no longer have to worry about disease and irrigation problems associated with woven mats.

Weed Barrier Mat is best used when transplanting. Lay the mat down to cover the entire planting area and simply cut an "X" large enough to allow for the digging and placement of the transplant. After planting, return the mat to its original position around the "X" cut, covering as much of the exposed soil as possible. Do not cut holes, because they leave exposed soil where weeds may germinate.

You can extend the already long expected life of this Weed Barrier Mat by covering it with a weed-free mulch (such as wood chips) to protect it from sunlight.
