



SUPER-LITE INSECT BARRIER

The ability of Super-Lite Insect Barrier to provide an effective barrier to several previously hard-to-control garden pests is remarkable. This fabric was developed specifically as an insect barrier. With previous row covers, insect control was an unexpected side benefit. Heat buildup was an especially troublesome problem with some crops. Super-Lite Insect Barrier was designed to avoid heat buildup. It is now possible to leave the cover on from seed to harvest. Be sure that plants are not covered during blossoming. Bees must be able to pollinate flowers so that plants will set fruit. (Crops like carrots, broccoli and radishes which are not grown for their fruit or seed, can remain covered up to a week before harvest without concern for pollination during blossoming.)

It is important to put covers on before pest larvae or eggs get on plants. Row covers can actually make matters worse by providing an environment where pests are protected from their natural enemies.

APPLICATION NOTES: Be sure there is plenty of slack to allow for plant growth. To apply, simply place the barrier over a row and cover 6 to 10 inches of each edge with soil, or use “U” pins, which make removal and repositioning easier. (By folding over the barrier’s edge to make a triple thickness, you can reduce fabric tearing.)
