Shake well before using. Mix one part Weed Aside Herbicidal Soap with 5 parts water (26 oz. in 1 gallon of water). Alternatively, for small, easy-to-kill weeds, mix one part Weed Aside Herbicidal Soap with 9 parts water (14 oz. in 1 gallon water). If rain falls within 3 hours of treatment, an additional spray may be required. Weed-Aside Herbicidal Soap controls many common annual weeds and suppresses the growth of some bi-annual and perennial weeds. It can be used in cultivated areas prior to planting grass, flowers and vegetables. Areas can be re-sown five days after treatment. 


