Directions for Use

IMPORTANT: Shake Well Before Diluting

Oil-Away™ Insecticide can be used as a light summer oil applied directly to foliage or other plant parts or as a dormant oil applied to the trunk and bark of perennial fruit, shade and ornamental trees and shrubs.

Oil-Away™ Insecticide is effective against adelgids, aphids, leafhopper nymphs, mealybugs, mites, plant bug nymphs, psyllids, sawfly larvae, scale, thips, and whitefly. This vegetable oil product will kill eggs and early stage nymphs and caterpillars and sawflies.

Oil-Away™ Insecticide is formulated as a concentrate. It is intended to be used in hand sprayers or pressurized sprayers after being diluted with tap water. One pint of Oil-AwayM Insecticide will make a total of 6.25 gallons of summer spray mixture and over 3 gallons of dormant oil mixture when diluted properly.

Peel back for Mixing Directions and Storage and Disposal instructions. Mixing Directions: Measure Oil-Away™ Insecticide according to the tables below, into a suitable mixing or spraying container, and mix well with one gallon of water.

For best results, please use the spray mixture at the time of mixing. Do not retain the mixed solution for a prolonged period before application.

Pesticidal oils kill insect pests by direct contact and must be applied with good coverage. This requires careful spraying into the center and underneath side of plant foliage. Repeated applications usually lead to improved performance of the spray.

There are thousands of cultivars and species of plants, so always conduct a test spray for plant sensitivity prior to making a full-scale application. We have not observed plant damage in any of the plant species that we have selected for experimental evaluation. These tests included most common vegetable, garden, ornamental, and shade plants.

Oil-Away™ Insecticide can be used as both a light summer oil and a dormant oil. This product is effective against almost all pests for which petroleum oils are recommended. The mode of action is the same and the application methods are the same.
