



8701 Ladd Apple Maggot Fly Trap & Lure

This is an effective trap for the control of apple maggot flies and is a substantial savings in comparison to spraying. There is more surface area to trap flies on the Ladd trap and it is effective on apple, plum and pear trees. The traps are reusable and the lures will keep indefinitely (if unused) in refrigeration. The apple scented lures are 20 times more effective than spheres alone.

- Yellow rectangle dimensions:
Height 8 ½ “ Width 11”

Assembly Instructions:

1. Fit the two pins on the base of each of the two red hemispheres through the four center holes in the yellow rectangle. Be sure to arrange the placement such that the pins of each hemisphere fit snugly into the holes of the other.
2. Using product #8678 Tangle Trap (sold separately), spread a thin coat of adhesive on both sides of the trap. Be sure to cover the hemispheres and the rectangle as completely as possible.
3. Place one of the apple maggot fly time release lures anywhere on the sticky yellow surface. Replace with a fresh lure every 3 to 4 weeks. Be sure to keep unused lures tightly capped in their container and preferably in the refrigerator.

Monitoring Strategy:

1. Five weeks after petal fall, hang a Ladd Apple Maggot Fly trap on the south side of a tree at eye level, using one trap per planting up to one acre.
2. Check the trap daily.

For *small plantings* hang one trap per tree.

For *large plantings* (one half-acre or more) this strategy involves placing:

1. One trap in every wild or abandoned tree within 300 to 400 yards of the orchard perimeter.
2. One trap every 100 feet of the outside row of the orchard perimeter.(especially near possible sources of migration)
3. A minimum of one trap per acre throughout the interior of the orchard block.
