

Turf Alive![®] III With Rhizomes

Rhizome enhanced grass that has self-repairing characteristics.

Turf Alive![®] III With Rhizomes has excellent traffic tolerance and is suitable for entire lawn seeding or over-seeding of existing lawns.

- Contains high levels of endophyte nature's own safe pesticide.
- Improved stress recuperation.
- Improved disease resistance including brown patch, typhula blight, pythium blight, pink patch, and many other diseases.
- Grows slower, between mowings, thus reducing mowing requirements.
- High density and good color year round.
- Strong root system can go down as far as 6 feet. Also has natural ability to spread out (through rhizomes) and fill in bare spots with new plants.
- Requires less water and fertilizer than typical Northern cool season grass.
- Quickly fills in to create a beautiful lawn.

SEED BED PREPARATION: Plowing or spading followed by discing and hand raking are the best methods. Rotary tillers may also be used. Work soil to a fine, granular texture. If any clods are left, rake them off the seed bed.

SEEDING: Sow at the rate of 6 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. Grass is best sown with a drop or rotary spreader. To obtain a uniform stand of turf, sow at 1/2 the recommended rate in one direction then sow the other 1/2 crosswise to the first sowing. This will prevent "rows". With regular watering, emergence will occur in 7-10 days.

TO OVERSEED: Sow at the rate of one or two lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. (more if existing grass is very thin). For best results, cover with a thin layer of top soil or aerate with a power aerator so that seed will be mixed with soil. Germination will be poor if seed is sown over existing lawn and is left exposed on the soil surface. If left exposed, apply at the rate of six lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.

FERTILIZATION: Do not fertilize until after the first mowing. (Tender sprouts can be affected by rapid biological activity.) Cover seed lightly by hand raking. Mulching with a light covering of straw or hay will improve germination and sprouting survival by preventing drying of soil surface.

NOTE: Do Not Use Where Ruminants And Horses May Feed.
