



# Pepper Food

All-Natural Fertilizer (4-4-3)

## Directions

### New Plantings:

- When setting out plants, dig a hole as needed for each individual pepper plant. Before planting, place 2 Tbsp. of Gurney's Pepper Food in the hole and mix thoroughly into the soil.

### Existing Plantings:

- When the pepper plants begin to set fruit, sprinkle 2 Tbsp. of Gurney's Pepper Food around the base of each plant and mix into the topsoil.
