All-Natural Fertilizer (4-4-4)

Directions

New Plantings:

- Before planting new blueberry shrubs, apply 1 cup per plant in the hole at planting time. Water into the soil thoroughly, and then place the shrub in the hole.

Existing Plantings:

- Apply at the rate of 1 lb. per 20 sq. ft. in late winter or early spring. Broadcast evenly under blueberry shrubs and then scratch into the top 2 in. of soil. Be careful not to disturb the roots. If roots are shallow, water the fertilizer into the soil thoroughly.
- For larger acid-loving trees and shrubs, broadcast under the rain drip canopy of each individual tree or shrub at the above rate. Water the fertilizer into the soil thoroughly.
