Each of these seven moths may be attracted by the pheromone lure in the Peach Tree Borer Trap. It is important to check the trap to see which kind of moth, or moths, it has caught. If you find a large number of Peach Tree Borer Moths, indicating a heavy infestation, refer to your Gardens Alive! catalog for recommendations.
