DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product fills the continuing need of all plants for a full range of nutrients and is a convenient means of applying fertilizer at planting time, with feeding that lasts up to 2 years.

FOR NEW PLANTINGS: Position plant in a hole and backfill halfway up the root ball. Place two tablets beside the root ball, about 1 inch from the root tips, one on each side—not at the bottom of the hole. Complete backfill, tamp and water.

FOR ESTABLISHED PLANTINGS: Insert tablets about every 18 inches in holes around drip-lines and between the drip-line and trunk. Drill or punch holes 4-6 inches deep.
